#### ACADEMIC PRESENTATION BY PROF. LAUREN ILA MISIASZEK

An academic presentation hosted by the Ministry of Academics, International Student Council, was delivered by Prof. Lauren on April 29, 2014 at the Faculty of Education, Beijing Normal University. The presentation was the first in a monthly series of academic presentations designed to bring faculty and students together outside of class for interactive and participatory dialogues. Prof. Lauren presented the topic "Using bell hooks to reflect on our own pedagogical practices: a workshop dialogical with faculty and students". The presentation was supplemented by interactive discussions especially focused on recognizing every student in a class. From the presentation, the participants were able to generate ideas of what "critical pedagogy" can look like in the classroom. Students and staff from BNU and other universities attended the presentation.
