
# 3+1+G MA Program in Developmental Psychology

This is an **accelerated MA program** designed for high-achieving international undergraduates interested in broadening their education in research and practices in human development. With focus on growth and development across the lifespan, the program covers social and emotional development, cognition, learning, parent-child relationships, gender, culture, racial/ethnic minority groups, socioeconomic status, and psycholinguistics.

#### **PROGRAM STRUCTURE**

- 1. Students completes their first three years of undergraduate study at their home institution.
- +1 program: Students who meet the initial admission criteria joins SF State and complete both undergraduate and graduate courses offered by the Psychology Department.\*
- +G program: Students who meet the final MA admission criteria pursue accelerated MA degree with an emphasis in Developmental Psychology.
- 4. Upon successful completion, San Francisco State University (SF State) will award students the master's degree.

<sup>\*</sup>Portion of the academic credits will be accepted by home institution towards graduation requirements. Students will be issued undergraduate diplomas by home institution.

# **Tuition Fees and Expenses**

#### Initial Admission Criteria

- In 3<sup>rd</sup> academic year of undergraduate study
- A copy of current transcript
- Foreign language test taken within the last two years: TOEFL iBT score of at least 80, or IELTS score of at least 6.5, or PTE score of 53
- A statement of purpose
- · Two letters of recommendation

#### Final MA Admission Criteria

- Successful completion of the +1 part of the program at SF State; No GRE required
- Undergraduate degree from the home institution
- A recommendation letter from SF State faculty

## +1 program tuition fee:

- Application fee: \$150
- Tuition: \$13,400 (one academic year)\*

### +G program tuition fee:

- Application fee: \$55
- Tuition: \$20,896 (one academic year and a summer session)\*

Tuition includes transportation pass for local buses and trains, access to fitness and aquatics facilities, outdoor recreation, cultural events and sports, advising services and more.

Estimated living expenses: \$20,020/academic year
