Summer Program for Trilateral Cooperation Program Guidelines

1. About the SPTC

Tokyo Gakugei University aims to cultivate the well-educated human resources of educators and educational specialists having high knowledge. In order to deal with the aspects of modern society, such as the growth of a knowledge-based society, increasing globalization, the diversification of educational challenges, and the exhaustion of local communities, we especially put emphasis on four key strengths: the strength to work together to solve challenges, the strength to value the diversity, the strength to reflect on and express themselves, and the strength to create a new society. CAMPUS Asia is one of the refined programs working for such goals.

This summer, Tokyo Gakugei University provides the Summer Program for Trilateral Cooperation (SPTC) again. This is the short-term exchange program providing the opportunities of learning Japanese education, culture and society. This program is designed for the undergraduate and graduate students of Beijing Normal University, Seoul National University of Education and Tokyo Gakugei University. We aim to expand it to other teachers colleges in East Asia Area in the future.

2. Program Outline

5 from Seoul National University of Education

Date: Mon, July 29, 2019 ~ Mon, August 5, 2019

Location: Tokyo Gakugei University Koganei Campus, Tokyo metropolitan area, TGU affiliated elementary school and private junior high / high school etc.

Contents:

- Lectures on the characteristics of Japanese education system, the education methods and the actual school life



- School visit and exchange activities at Tokyo Gakugei University Setagaya Elementary School and private junior high / high schools
- Group discussion with undergraduate / graduate students and teachers from China, South Korea and Japan
- Experience and Understanding Japanese culture (EX: Observing Edo-Tokyo Architecture Museum, Calligraphy, Tea ceremony, Kimono experience etc.)
- * This program will be conducted in Japanese, but we will provide support in Chinese, Korean and English for helping the participants better understand. TGU professors and staff will lead the activities, and TGU students will support them during the program.
